

#### **The Seattle Public Library**

City's Population: 620,778 Library established: 1890

Number of Libraries: 27 locations plus Mobile Services

Staff Population: 613 (FTE)

Librarians: 127\*

- 110 Librarians, Senior Librarians and Selection Services Librarians
- 1 Systems Librarian
- 16 Managing Librarians
- 6 Temporary Librarians\*

2011 Circulation: 11,572,778 items

2011 Visits: 14.3 million (6.7 in-person, 7.6 virtual)

2011 Collection size: 2,403,693




