Dalongdong Shopping District are two to three hundred years old. There are Confucius Temple and Bao'an Temple here. Dalong Elementary School is also established over one century. Dalongdong Shopping District combines temples and schools. The birthday celebration of Baosheng Emperor on March 15th of lunar calendar becomes a festival of art and religion. With worshipers flocking here, Bao'an Temple host famous culture events, attracting hundreds of thousands of people every year.

Daqiaotou Yansan Shopping District

Attraction (Mainly night market, street food, and scooter related industry) Being close to Tamsui River, rice are the main produce here. People use rice as the ingredient of rice cakes, zongzi, and thick rice noodles. With the easy access and need for related products, this commercial district attracts lot of wholesalers, given the name of "the street of rice cakes". It leads Taiwan in rice consuming culture. There are used scooter shops, scooter parts shops, and scooter repair shops as well. Here offers the main source of used scooters in Taiwan. It's called the training ground of scooter mechanics in early days, playing a vital role in scooter repair and used scooter selling through out Taiwan.
