The Huaxi St. Night Market is the most famous international night market in Taipei. With over half a century of history, the market is known for nutritious food, foods with Chinese herbal supplements, artworks, general merchandise, and snacks. The snacks are famous for their variety of fresh



seafood, including fresh squid, eel, cuttlefish, and fresh oysters. Other traditional foods play an important role at Huaxi St. Tourist Night Market, including Tainan Dan-a noodles, rice with braised pork, zongzi, thick soup of fish and shrimp, pork nuggets in thick soup, sticky rice porridge, and shrimp cooked in rice wine. Above all, the most famous delicacies are medicinal foods, cooked with snake and turtle.

## The historical facts about Monga

Wanhua was formerly known as Monga before. (Monga is the transliteration of Moungar in the aboriginal language, meaning the gathering place for canoes), and was a fortress at the juncture of land and lake. It was the first commodity distribution center in the Taipei basin and Guiyang Street in Monga was known as Taipei's First Street. Since Monga did lots of trade with Mainland China, Monga was named for one of primary transport hubs. Wanhua nowadays features the famous Huaxi Street Night Market as well as several streets with unique characteristics. It continuously attracts tourists and transforms an old street into a new look.



### Monga Qingshan Temple 02-23822296

An old historical building now designated as a third-grade national historical site, Monga Qingshan Temple was built in 1854 as a place to worship the deity Lignan Zunwang, and recently underwent a major renovation.



### The Red House 02-23119380

The octagonal Red House is a third-grade national historical site and has existed for over a century. After renovation, the Central Display Area on the first floor and the Pinwheel Café offer to the public the best place for opera and exhibition.

dragon boat image in Monga. The park is separated into three large squares (Temple Square, Shanshui W. St. Square and S. Wing Square), the beauty looking into the mirror pond, cultural gallery and underground shopping St..

Monga Folk Park is a great place for the residents of Taipei and visitors to rest and chat. Its unique architectural images are combined with the traditional, historical culture of Longshan Temple, glowing with elegance of old Monga.



### Foot Massage

Among all the folk remedies found on the Longshan Temple Underground Shopping Bazaar, foot massage is one



of the most common traditional remedies. Foot massage is a type of health therapy focused on the foot's reflex zones and involves stimulation by massaging the reflex zones of pathological organs or glands.

## Witnessing the Rise and Fall of Bangka; History of Bangka

Witnessing its rise and fall, Bangka still retains numerous humble yet very significant historic sites that can best serve to tell its immigration history.

### Nursery Hall

Today's Renji Hospital is the former Nursery Hall, which is similar to our orphanage hall today, with a "Monument of Danbei Nursery Hall" standing next to the site.

### Liao Kuan Matsu Temple

The camphor trees harvested by the timber industry in the early days from the Xindian River were transported to Huanhe South Road by boats to the Danshui River bank. "Liao Kuan Street" is named after the handling of loads of woods at this site.

### Temple of the Huang Clan

The Temple of the Huang Clan used to be the private residence of the rich merchant Huang Lu in Bangka. For the grateful remembrance of the merchant Huang Longan who settled disputes, the residence was donated to be the temple of the Huang Clan.

### Yi Tsang Monument

On Xiyuan Rd. Section One at the current address of the Wanghua Police Station there used to be a storage house in remembrance of the rich people who donated rice to help the poor people to get through lean harvest seasons.

Prices are reasonable due to competition among the vendors and there is a wide variety of goods available. The street is completely lined with shops. The street has been planned and reconstructed, which attracts crowds of people and gives the night market a bustling atmosphere.

Longshan Temple is the best representative temple of Taipei and a must-visited attraction for foreign tourists. Currently classified as a second-grade national historic site, the main hall is dedicated to the worship of Avalokitesvara, the Goddess of Mercy, while the rear hall is filled with many statues of Buddhas and deities. Throughout the year people come here to worship, especially during the lively holidays and festivals, when crowds gather from all over Taiwan.

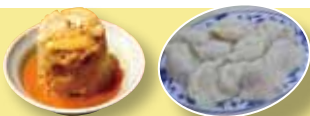

**"N**anjichang" used to be military airport, established by the Japanese military in this area. As Japan's rule ended, the area was converted into public housing and a community for military dependents, and slowly developed into the Nanjichang Night Market. The market specializes in popular food at reasonable prices, including oyster dei (fried oysters), cold noodles, Water dumplings, Fried baozi, and Canned-Glutinous Rice, which leave a delicious and lingering, unforgettable taste. The area has recently attracted a number of dumpling shops, earning it a new nickname, "Dumpling Street."

The History Facts

## The South Airport, a military training site

The South Airport area was used as a military training site during Japan's rule and was called Machangding. It was given the name South Airport because it was also used as a military airport. After Taiwan's retrocession, this area was turned into an Air Force military community and the first Public Housing. Later a golf court for the rich was constructed at the site of South Airport. The former President Chiang Ching-kuo decided to convert this place to the Youth Park to offer leisure services to the public.

### Ximending Commercial District

Ximending has a reputation for being a commercial district on the cutting edge of trends and fashion as well as a great place for strolling and shopping. Tourists may enjoy a variety of foods and visit several attractions popular with young people.

### Youth Park

In 1953, the Taipei Golf Club was built here. In 1974 the government took over the area and converted it into the Youth Park. Featuring beautiful landscapes, it's covered with trees and plants, and equipped with various recreation facilities.

It is located by the Xindian River in the south of Wanhua District, or near Zhonghua Rd. Sec. 2, Quanzhou St., and Shuiyuan Rd.. It was known as an execution ground but now has been transformed to Machangding Memorial Park.

There is a legend that Lu Dongbin, one of the Eight Immortals, left a footprint here, making the area famous and attracting travelers curious to see the immortal's footprint.

The most common surnames among the Anxi Tea agricultural immigrants in the Wenshan District are Gao, Zhang, and Lin, and in order to worship Baoyi Zunwang Zhangxun and Baoyi Dafu Xuyuan, several Jiying Temples were built. They include the Gao Family Jiying Temple, in Jingmei Market, the Lin Family Jiying Temple, nearby Wugong Elementary School, the Zhang Family Jiying Temple, across from Muzha Middle School, and the Jishun Temple, by the Shenkeng Temple.

The Raohe St. Night Market was the first to be planned by the government. It starts in the west from Bade Rd. Sec. 4 (in front of Ciyou Temple) and stretches to the Tayou Rd. intersection (formerly known as Xikou St.), a total of 600 meters. The Songshan Fude Temple and Ciyou Temple function as spiritual centers for the area. A variety of clothing, home furnishing, special foods and traditional snacks are available for reasonable prices at the night market stalls. The most popular foods are traditional Taiwanese snacks such as pork rib stewed in Chinese medicine, Bing with pepper seasoning, Fried baozi, Vermicelli in starched soup with oysters, spicy stinky tofu, and all kinds of beverages. As a nocturnal animal, owl shares the same work-rest schedule with night market vendors, and thus it has become a mascot of Raohe St. Night Market.

## Raohe St. formerly known as Xikou St.

The area near Raohe St. and Songshan Station was formerly known as Xikou in the early days. It had always been an important transport hub in the Keelung River where merchants would gather and boats would dock for trading. The business activities in Raohe St. commercial district gradually declined because of sediment deposition in the river, making water traffic less and less, and the widening of Bade Rd.. The night market was not established until 1987 when the vendors moved to Raohe St. from South Songshan.

No.761, Sec. 4 Bade Rd., Songshan District, Taipei City.

The Songshan Ciyou Temple was built in 1753. The residents worshipped Mazu to come from Meizhou to Taiwan, where they built the temple in Xikou as a pilgrimage for Mazu. The temple faces south in front of the mountains (Sishou peaks) and behind the water (Keelung River). Over the course of two centuries and seven expansions, the temple has grown into the biggest religious center in the district.

Wufenpu Clothing Market is the biggest wholesale garment distribution in Taipei and a great place for fashionable apparel and clothing. A variety of stores specialize in fashionable, reasonably-priced imports from Korea, Japan, Hong Kong and mainland China.

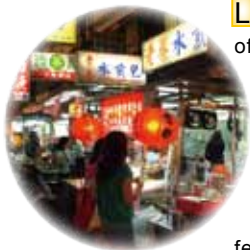

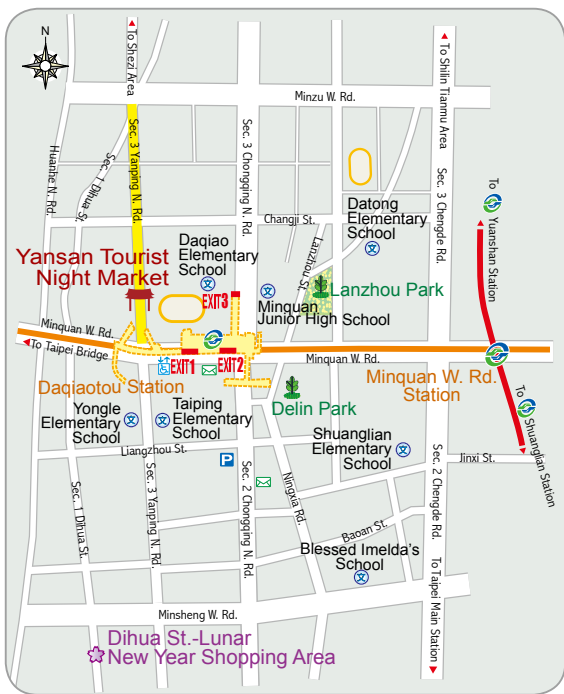

## Taipei Bridge

- 1888 Start of official construction.
- 1889 The construction was completed. The bridge was a wooden structure and carried railway tracks.
- 1895 The bridge was renamed "Danshui Bridge" when the Japanese government took over Taiwan.
- 1899 The old railway was removed. The construction of a new railway and a new iron bridge was completed.
- 1920 Danshui Bridge was renamed "Taipei Bridge". In the same year, it was damaged caused by the surge of flood waters.
- 1925 Reconstruction of the iron bridge was completed, which allowed the passage of vehicles. Became one of the eight scenic highlights of Taipei.
- 1969 Construction was completed, From an old iron bridge to a new concrete bridge.
- 1987 Taipei Bridge was proposed to be converted into six lanes of automobile traffic from four lanes.
- 1996 Construction was completed and the new bridge was open to traffic, which is the current Taipei Bridge.

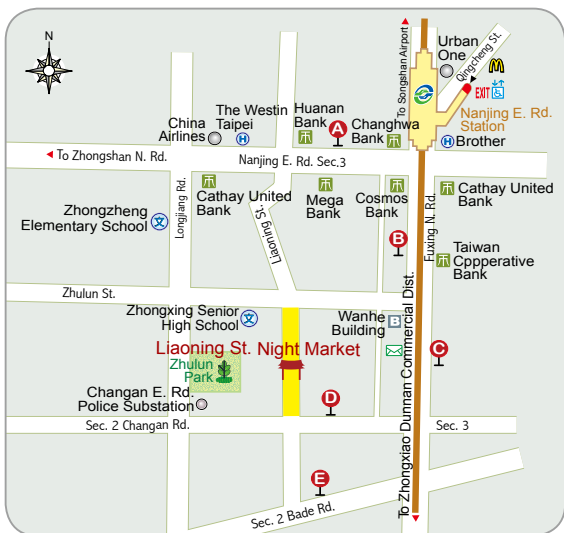

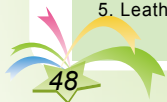

The greatest difference between Siping Sun Square and night markets is that the former opens in the daytime. The whole street is a pedestrian area. The comfortable shopping area and open-air coffee shops allow people to enjoy a relaxing break in the afternoon. As the market gains increasing international attention and foreign visitors, numerous shops now provide English and Japanese language guided tour services.

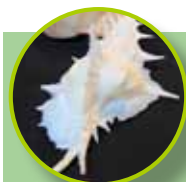
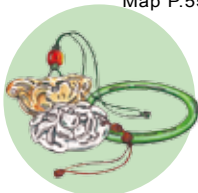

## 1. *Beef Noodle*

Boiling big chunks of beef at low heat for making soup stock gives the soup an irresistible aromatic flavor. This, a famous traditional dish in Taipei, is served in three styles: brown soup, clear soup and tomato soup.



## 2. *Rice with Pig's feet*

Fragrant and chewy steamed rice with a flavorful braised pork sauce topping and combined with fatty and tender pig feet. This dish is a food lovers' favorite, and the most fulfilling rice dish for your stomach.



## 3. *Oyster omelette*

Pan-fried fresh oysters, a topping with thickening cornstarch, one egg, some green leafy veggies, soy sauce and sweet chili sauce, this dish is the most commonly seen snack in night markets.



## 4. *Zongzi(sticky rice wrapped in bamboo leaves)*

A traditional delicacy made with glutinous rice and other ingredients such as dried mussel, pork, and egg yolk, all wrapped with leaves into a unique triangular shape.



## 5. *Vermicelli in starched soup with oysters*

Commonly known as vermicelli paste, this dish is made with well-cooked red vermicelli, a topping with some large fresh oysters, chewy pig colon and fragrant cilantro. Add some minced garlic, dark vinegar and hot chili for more flavor.



## 6. *Stinky Tofu*

Fermented tofu radiates a unique yet nearly intolerable odor, but after it is deep fried at high temperature, it is transformed into irresistible and addictive golden yummy bites of tofu. With spicy and sour pickled vegetables, garlic soy sauce and hot chili.





### **7. Tempura**

Mash fish meat into a paste, Continually mix and knead into a thick liquid, take a small amount to form into a round flat shape, and then deep fry until both sides become golden brown, what you get is a very popular snack in night markets- tempura.



### **8. Rice with braised pork**

Slow-cooked minced pork on steamed rice gives plain rice extra flavor and taste.



### **9. Spring Roll**

As a special snack for folk holidays, it is made with a thin flour wrap, and its stuffing contains shredded carrots, bean curds, bean sprouts, peanut powder and more. Top with sweet chili sauce for the final touch of a mouthwatering spring roll. You can also try a different taste by having it deep fried.



### **10. Pork rib stewed in Chinese medicine**

Steam or deep fry chewy sausage casings filled with glutinous rice. They are then cut open and topped with seasonings for a tasty night market snack. Nowadays, a unique and perfect way to further enjoy them is to insert a link of pork sausage and you have a double-sausage sandwich.



### **11. Sticky rice in tube**

Steam or deep fry chewy sausage casings filled with glutinous rice. They are then cut open and topped with seasonings for a tasty night market snack. Nowadays, a unique and perfect way to further enjoy them is to insert a pork sausage and you have a double-sausage sandwich.



### **12. Taiwanese fried chicken**

Deep-fry chicken chunks at high temperature until they turn crispy, combine with aromatic basil leaves, sprinkle some salt and pepper, then you have one of the most popular snacks in Taiwan.





### 13. *Bing with scallion*

The flour pancake of multiple thin layers is pan-fried at slow heat to slightly golden brown, with scallion's unique aroma and seasoning sauce, it is the best choice to satisfy your cravings.



### 14. *Stewed pork in steamed bun (Gua Bao)*

Soft flour bun wraps creamy and slightly greasy soy sauce stewed streaky pork, topping with flavorings of cilantro and peanut powder, this is the most flavorful traditional Taiwanese folk style snack.



### 15. *Pork Sausage*

Pork sausage is definitely one of the most popular night market snacks. In recent years, they have evolved into various flavors with enhanced taste.



### 16. *Chicken cooked with sesame oil*

First stir-fried chicken meat with sesame oil and aged ginger, then add rice wine to cook this winey and flavorful sesame oil chicken soup. Rich and creamy sesame flavor, compounding with rice wine's aroma, this delicacy is complete with perfect appearance, fragrance and taste.



### 17. *Round cake with red bean paste filling*

Also known as Wheel cake, this snack is made by pouring flour on heated ironware at high-temperature, adding various fillings such as red beans, butter or cabbage on one side of the flour cap, and then covering it with the other side, forming a great taste of crispy brown crust with warm and creamy fillings.



### 18. *Fried baozi*

Slightly pan-fry the steamed buns with stuffing (also known as Shui Jian Bao), and then add some water mixed with flour and cover them up until the water boils and the buns are cooked. Unlike steamed buns' soft and chewy texture, pan-fried buns are slightly burned and crispy.





### 19. Mochi (Sticky rice cake)

Steam glutinous rice, smashing it into dough, continually kneading it to reach perfect stickiness, and then boil it in hot water before serving. The unique cooking method is the only way to make this popular snack.



### 20. Bing with pepper seasoning

Made with thick flour dough stuffed with juicy pork, scallion and black pepper, this baked snack is mouthwatering. When biting into the crispy bun, the juicy stuffing will burst forth, offering a wonderful taste.



### 21. Fruit with syrup coating on a stick

The traditional way to make this popular snack is to pierce Lindley's pears with a bamboo stick, then add a layer of transparent reddish sweet crispy coating on it. Now Lindley's pears are replaced with other fresh fruits such as tomatoes and strawberries for a more diverse flavor.



### 22. Pao-pao Ice (Shaved ice stirred with ingredients)

Put some lemon, blueberries, pineapple and other fruits into a bowl, and then place it under an ice shaving machine. Allow flaky ice to fall into the bowl like snow flakes until it is full, and quickly stir the shaved ice with ingredients with a spoon into the best refreshing snack of various flavors.



### 23. Tofu Pudding

This unique Taiwanese dessert can be served warm or cold. It is similar to tofu, but has an extra smooth and distinctive texture. You can add some peanuts or green beans to it and have it refreshingly cold or soothingly warm.



### 24. Frog Eggs (pearls in sweet sauce)

As one of specialties of Taiwan, tapioca balls are added to a variety of icy desserts. Because of their shape and appearance, they look like frog eggs and thus the name. They have a chewy texture and the refreshing drinks are bound to be well-liked.



### 25. Pearl Milk Tea

This snack earns the designation as a national treasure of Taiwan. Translucent pearl-like tapioca balls are added into milk tea for the special enjoyment of both drinking a refreshing beverage and chewing the tapioca balls.
