# **Regulations Governing Megacity Pass Use**

Amendments Published on July 12, 2024

### I. Basis of Distribution

Pursuant to the Executive Yuan's Initiative to Promote the Use of Public Transportation, the Taipei Rapid Transit Corporation (TRTC) has been authorized by the Keelung City Government, Taipei City Government, New Taipei City Government, and Taoyuan City Government (hereafter referred to as the Taipei-Keelung-Taoyuan area governments) to distribute Megacity Passes.

# II. Megacity Pass & Description

The Megacity Pass is a commuter ticket sold for NT\$1,200 that allows for unlimited trips of unlimited distance on nearly all public transportation in the Taipei-Keelung-Taoyuan metropolitan areas within a 30-day validity period. Megacity Passes are usable on the following public transportation systems:

- 1. <u>Metro and light rail transit (LRT):</u> All metro and LRT lines operated by the New Taipei Metro Corporation and TRTC (Taipei Metro), and the Taoyuan Metro Corporation-operated Taoyuan Airport MRT;
- 2. <u>City buses:</u> All city bus routes in Keelung City, New Taipei City, Taipei City, and Taoyuan City (for the most current list of applicable routes, please refer to relevant announcements made by the Taipei-Keelung-Taoyuan area governments);
- 3. <u>Taiwan Railways (TRA):</u> All train types traveling between (inclusive): Keelung Station and Xinfu Station on the Western Trunk line; Badu Station and Fulong Station on the Yilan Line; and all stations on the Shen'ao Line and Pingxi Line; with the exception of any exclusive train types that do not offer non-reserved seating (e.g. sightseeing special, private charter, Taroko Express, Puyuma Express, or EMU3000 trains).
- 4. <u>Intercity buses:</u> Applicable routes\_and boarding zones are detailed in Appendix 1;
- 5. <u>YouBike:</u> Passholders enjoy the first 30 minutes of any YouBike rental session within Taipei City and New Taipei City for free, whereas rentals within Taoyuan City are free for the first 60 minutes. The above terms are not applicable for YouBike 2.0E models.

#### III. Purchase and Extension of the Pass

- A. Megacity Passes can be stored in the following devices:
  - All general physical EasyCards, including Adult EasyCards, Co-Branded EasyCards, EasyCard Debit Cards, Samsung Wallet EasyCards, SuperCard EasyCards, Telecom EasyCards, Student EasyCards, and Digital Student ID EasyCards (issued by

- county/city governments or schools to students over 12 years old). If using a Co-Branded EasyCard Credit or Debit Card, the remaining validity of the card must be no less than 60 days.
- 2. Further announcements will be made if additional devices that can be used to store MegaCity Passes become available.
- 3. There is a limit to one commuter ticket type per card. In the event that you wished to purchase another type of commuter ticket, you would have to wait until your Megacity Pass had expired to do so.

#### B. Methods of Purchase:

EasyCards: Purchase and set up your Megacity Pass by bringing your EasyCard to any New Taipei Metro station information counters (see Appendix 2), Taipei Metro, or Taoyuan Metro station (except A20 Xingnan Station); designated TRA ticketing offices (see Appendix 3 for details); the EasyCard Customer Service Center in Taipei City Hall Bus Station; and EasyCard Sale & Add Value Machines within Kuo-Kuang's Keelung Station, Taipei Station, Nangang Station, Banqiao Station, Taoyuan Airport Station, and Zhongli Station; any FamiPort kiosks within FamilyMart; or the ticket vending machines on 1F of Keelung's E-Square Mall (Erxin Loop Station) or Keelung Transit Station. SuperCard holders may also purchase passes through the Easy Wallet app; Samsung Wallet EasyCard holders may purchase passes through the Samsung Wallet app.

#### C. Methods of Extension:

<u>EasyCards</u>: One may extend the Megacity Pass on their original card by reloading it in the 10-day period before the pass expires. SuperCard holders may also extend their passes through the Easy Wallet app; Samsung Wallet EasyCard holders may extend their passes through the Samsung Wallet app.

D. When purchasing a Megacity Pass, fees will be automatically deducted from the balance of the EasyCard or Easy Wallet used to store the pass. In the event of an insufficient balance, one must deposit sufficient funds into their account before the transaction can be completed.

## IV. Activation and Validity Period

#### A. Activation

To activate the pass, place it over the automatic payment sensor at the gates of any metro, LRT, or TRA station or on buses. For TRA and intercity bus rides, both the boarding and disembarking stations must be located within Keelung City, New Taipei City, Taipei City, or Taoyuan City for the pass to successfully activate. If either the boarding or disembarking station for a trip falls outside of these areas, the Megacity Pass cannot be activated or used for that journey, and the

- original fare will be deducted instead. A Megacity Pass must be activated within the period of 30 days after the date of purchase.
- 2. If a Megacity Pass is still valid when one purchases an extension, the extension period will automatically begin one day after the original Megacity Pass expires. If the pass has already expired when you purchase an extension, the pass is activated on the first day of use (the pass must be activated within the period of 30 days after the date of purchase).
- 3. Megacity Passes cannot be activated at YouBike kiosks. Passholders must first activate their pass at one of the aforementioned activation locations, then register as a YouBike member and link their EasyCard number to their account if they wish to rent a YouBike. Upon completing registration, one will be eligible to enjoy the first 30 minutes of any YouBike rental session within Taipei City and New Taipei City for free, and the first 60 minutes of any YouBike rental session within Taoyuan City for free.
- B. Validity Period: Lasts for a period of 30 days beginning from the date of activation (inclusive).

### V. Refunds and Lost Cards

#### A. Refunds

- 1. No refunds can be issued once an activated Megacity Pass has expired. Passes which have not been activated within 30 days of purchase can be refunded.
- 2. EasyCards: Activated Megacity Passes can be refunded at any New Taipei Metro station information counters (see Appendix 2), Taipei Metro stations, Taoyuan Metro stations (except A20 Xingnan Station), TRA ticketing offices, the EasyCard Customer Service Center in Taipei City Hall Bus Station, or the ticket vending machines on 1F of Keelung's E-Square Mall (Erxin Loop Station) or Keelung Transit Station within their validity period.
- 3. Any refunded credit will be reimbursed to one's EasyCard. Refunds are calculated as follows: The original pass price minus (daily amount x number of days) minus an NT\$20 handling fee. The "daily amount" is NT\$300 per day. If the refund amount is negative, no refund will be given.
- 4. The above "number of days" is calculated as follows: From the day of activation (inclusive) to the day of refund (inclusive). For cards that have not been activated, the number of days is 0. If the Megacity Pass has been activated, the day of refund is included in the number of days subtracted from the amount refunded.
- 5. Once a refund has been completed for a Megacity Pass, the pass immediately expires and cannot be used anymore.

#### B. Lost Cards

- 1. Unregistered cards cannot be reported as lost.
- 2. If your card is registered by ID number and has been lost, stolen, robbed, swindled, or is otherwise held by another person, please contact the card issuer to report your card as missing and deactivate it (for co-branded cards, please contact the card issuing bank).
- 3. If one's Student ID Card has been lost, stolen, robbed, swindled, or is otherwise held by another person, please contact the school that issued the card to report your card as missing and deactivate it. If one's Student ID Card is registered by ID number, one may also contact the card issuer.
- 4. The cardholder is liable for any transactions made within the period of three hours after registering the card as missing.
- After a card issuer is notified of a lost card, refunds are calculated as follows:
  - (1) For the first reported loss of a registered card within the current year (from January 1 to December 31), the refund amount is calculated using the original pass price minus (NT\$40 x number of days passed) plus a NT\$20 handling fee. Amounts less than NT\$1 shall be rounded off without any further conditions. The above "number of days passed" is calculated as follows: From the day of activation (inclusive) to the date of report (inclusive). The card issuer will issue your refund through their appointed refund channel, restricted to a single refund per individual per year.
  - (2) For the second and subsequent reported losses of a registered card within the current year, the refund amount will be calculated according to policy as stipulated in Article V, Section A, and the refunded amount will be issued through their appointed refund channel.

## C. Viewing Transaction History:

Cardholders can view their transaction history by bringing their card containing a Megacity Pass to any 7-ELEVEN ibon kiosk; FamilyMart FamiPort kiosk; Enquiry Machine (EQM) at any metro, LRT, or TRA station; or by using their card issuer's app.

# VI. Terms of Use

A. Megacity Pass passholders are required to comply with the regulations governing the use of the metro, LRT, TRA, buses, and YouBikes. Violation of these regulations may result in the card being locked and rendered unusable on other modes of transportation. In such cases, cardholders must return to the original transaction carrier to have the card unlocked; no deductions will be made for unlocking a card. Please refer to Appendix 4 for information on how having a locked card can affect

- travel on various transport providers.
- B. A Megacity Pass allows unlimited trips of unlimited distance within its 30-day validity period. One cannot apply for a refund or compensation if they no longer use the Megacity Pass due to illness, injury, or other personal reasons.
- C. If one has been affected by a service interruption during the validity period of their Megacity Pass, they may request compensation in accordance with the regulations of the affected transport operator.
- D. A Megacity Pass is only valid for one passenger at a time. If it is found there were multiple users, anyone who used the ticket other than the cardholder will be deemed as riding without a ticket, pursuant to the regulations of the relevant transport provider.
- E. Please keep your card in good condition. Protect the card from damage by dirt, water, scratching, abrasion, heat, or other deformation. If such damage makes the ticket unreadable, it may no longer be usable to ride public transportation with. You may bring your ticket to any New Taipei Metro or Taipei Metro station information counter, or the EasyCard Customer Service Center in Taipei City Hall Bus Station, for handling, or apply for a refund on the EasyCard Corp. official website. If it is discovered that the card was damaged due to the reasons listed above, the Megacity Pass balance will be refunded pursuant to Article V, Section A.
- F. If a Megacity Pass fails to read for unknown reasons, please contact the card issuer or bring the card to any New Taipei Metro or Taipei Metro station information counters, or the EasyCard Customer Service Center in Taipei City Hall Bus Station, or apply on the EasyCard Corp. official website for assistance. A pro-rata refund will be calculated using the original pass price minus (NT\$40 x number of days passed). Amounts less than NT\$1 shall be rounded off without any further conditions.

#### VII. Other

- A. In case of revisions, the TRTC will announce revised items, terms, and effective dates on its website.
- B. Unless otherwise stipulated in this document, all other matters will be handled according to provisions promulgated by various transport operators.
- C. EasyCard usage shall be regulated according to the EasyCard Terms and Conditions provided by the EasyCard Corp.
