18	Initiation and the execution of 96 integrated health screenings in Taipei City: "Creating healthy life, stay away from cancer and chronic diseases" remote press conference. Promulgate the "Key implementation points for Taipei City Government institutions and schools over the prohibited use of novel and emerging nicotine and tobacco products."
February	
10	Implementation of the "Lunar New Year celebration with the Mayor and the Director-gen- eral: thanksgiving for the medical personnel. Mayor Wen-Je Ko, Deputy Mayor Shan-Shan Huang, and Director-general Shier-Chieg Huang went to the Yang Ming Branch and the Reassured Quarantine institution to hold thanksgiving event for the medical personnel.
17	The Health-Care Angel licensing event was held by Taipei City Hospital. Mayor Wen-Je Ko and Deputy Mayor Shan-Shan Huang awarded the nursing staff that completed the training with certification.
March	
1	Notification for "Starting March 1, 2021, the sidewalks around the Taipei European School (TES) become a smoking-free zone."
25	Carrying out the "2020 Excellent cancer prevention performance hospitals in Taipei City" award ceremony. Director-general Shier-Chieg Huang was present to hand out the award. A total number of 18 hospitals were awarded. 40 people took part in the event.
31	Mayor Wen-Je Ko and Director-general Shier-Chieg Huang took part in the opening cere- mony of the Chung Hsing long-term care institution.

14	Taipei City Epidemic Command Center established fortified collective quarantine station for the Department of Health, and the Department of Information and Tourism, Taipei City Government. Taipei City Hospital later that night made an announcement of the establishment of "Bopiliao Screening Station."
15	The Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced the since May 15, the Nation- al Epidemic Alert to level 3 for Taipei City and New Taipei City.
19	The Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced the since May 19, the Nation- al Epidemic Alert to level 3.

13	The activation of "COVID-19 vaccine appointment system" in Taipei City.
15	The Department of Health, Taipei City Government open long-term care hotline 1966, 1999 and tabulation by the borough wardens to register home-visit vaccination.
16	Activate precise COVID-19 tracing survey. Apart from identifying the potential contacts, there was also an expansion in the identification and screening those who may have over- lapped travel history, those in contact, risk of infection.
18	The "Bopiliao Screening Station" completed its temporary mission.
26	The Taipei City Hospital established "Wan Da engaging command center" and mobile screening bus.
July	
10	"COVID-19 Vaccination Registration and Reservation system" is launched and the retrieval of "COVID-19 vaccine appointment system" is terminated.
13	The Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced some loosening of the rules and regulations became effective starting July 13, the National Epidemic Alert remain level 3 until July 26.
14	Initiation of the large vaccination station at the Expo Dome from the Flora Expo.
August	
30	In co-ordination with the World Suicide Prevention Day, the Department of Health, Taipei City Government hosted the "Are you ok? Find hope around the corner! 2021 World Suicide Prevention Day live stream press conference." The live stream was done through the talk between soon Sun the Wackyboys and Chief Yu-Hung Lin from the Suicide Prevention Center, Taipei City Government. They call for the citizens to become the gatekeeper to prevent adolescent and themselves from suicide.
September	
17	Taipei City Hospital Kunming Prevention and Control Center hosted 26 "2021 Taipei City Hospital AIDS Prevention Touring Stage Play." Approximately 8,254 teachers and students took part. The event ended on December 3.
18	The reactivation of "COVID-19 vaccine appointment system" in Taipei City due to large- scale Moderna vaccine supply arrival in Taiwan.
