- 月 January 大事紀要 Major Events The country's first e-books for young people to quit smoking were formally 1 1 put online. Held the "Praising Good Pharmacists and Complete Pharmaceutical Services Symposium" to share experiences and have a discussion; good 16 pharmacists were thanked for often actively promoting public health related activities; about 300 people attended. Director Heng-yi Hua from Gansu Provincial Population Culture and 17 19 others visited the Women and Children Branch of the Taipei City Hospital to exchange ideas relating to population, women and children issues. Signed the Taipei Beitou Health & Wellness Center Operations Transfer 20 (OT) Case. In conjunction with the Taipei City Government Consumer Protection went to the street which selling New Year Foods and performed an on-site inspection focusing on bulk food labeling and whether the packaging was 29 in accordance with good hygienic practices. A total of 207 firms and food vendors were inspected along the street; among those 53 were counseled to improve and one of each packaging and bulk food product was randomly inspected. .月 February 大事紀要 Major Events 2 16 The library was opened at the Taipei City Hospital Research Division. The Zhongxing Branch of Taipei City Hospital held a series of activities 17 ending on February 19 for their 106th anniversary. Jin-ping Wu the Deputy Secretary of Health at Huaian Jiangsu, and 25 18 others visited Neihu District Health Services Center of Taipei City to promote cooperation in preventative health services. Cooperated with the Department of Economic Development to implement inspections of 8 large industries for the first half of the year; in all there were 174 firms, 110 were found to comply with regulations, while 19 did 18 not. 34 temporarily closed or firms not yet started were inspected; 11 were not in compliance with Taipei City's self-management regulations for the eight large industries. This ended on March 15.

- Held a press conference on healthy weight loss at Taipei City Government's

 Shen Pao-cheng Hall; Mayor Lung-bin Hau and leading Taiwan city groups started a healthy weight-control point collection activity and announced Taipei City's goal of a healthy weight loss of 101 ton.
 - Continued to hold free pre-school and primary integrated communityinspections services in Taipei's public and private kindergarten, serving 46,775 people.
 - Professional nutritionists provide national weight control hotline and consultation services from Monday to Friday 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM; for a period of 12 weeks of tracked consultation assisted residents taking steps to a healthy dieting lifestyle.
 - In 2011, held elementary training classes for pharmacists regarding long term care and safe drugs; in all there were 8 hours and 186 pharmacists attended.
 - With the Taiwan Society of Nephrology co-hosted a garden meeting for 2011 World Kidney Day—"Protect Kidney's, Protect Life" at Xinyi District, Ashanti Square; 3,000 people attended.
 - The Taipei Municipal Wanfang Hospital nursing home held an observation exercise regarding the nursing home's fire emergency response system.

On March 15 and April 27 held commercial food labeling workshops: "Cooking oil, healthy food products, and related manufacturing industries, and general merchandise markets, supermarkets, pharmacies, and direct marketed goods"—170 people attended; "candies, crackers, dry noodles, noodles, wheat products, frozen products and related manufacturing industries and stores, departments stores, etc. and industries"—208 people attended.

- On March 17 and May 18, Quanzhou in the mainland China became the first hospital medical personnel to visit the Department of Health, Taipei City Government to conduct exchanges on issues of hospital management and medical services.
- With the Taipei Sports Office held inspections of management and swimming pool safety; 95 places were inspected and 81 were found in compliance while 1 did not meet the regulations. 13 had been temporarily closed. Ended on May 13.

conference for the country's first 8 outdoor semi-open smoking areas; those in attendance included former Deputy Mayor of Taipei City Allen W. Chiu, Department of Health Taipei City Government's Chi-hung Lin and Deputy Commissioner Hsiu-lian Lin, Deputy Director of the Taipei City Hospitals Sun-yran Chang and Director of Bureau of Health Promotion, Department of Health, Executive Yuan Po-tswen Yu. About 100 people participated and outdoor smoking zones were set up at various sites of Taipei City Hospital including one in Zhongxing, two in Renai, one in Zhongxiao, one in Yangming, one in Songde, one in Heping Fuyou, and one in Taipei Station; the areas surrounding the zones were declared as non-smoking spaces.

The Heping Fuyou Branch of the Taipei City Hospital held a press

- On March 27, April 10 and April 17 held advanced training courses for pharmacists regarding long term care and safe drugs for 24 hours total; 126 pharmacists attended.
- Department of Health, Taipei City Government held Taipei City Government inspections of fruits and vegetables, poultry and aquatic products and held about 15 joint implementation meetings; they invited the Atomic Energy Commission, Executive Yuan to conduct a special session to increase Taipei City Government's knowledge of radiation protection with the topic of Radiation Safety and Protection in Japan's Fukushima Nuclear Power Plant Accident.

The Taiwan City Government held 2011 Taipei Nuclear Disaster Drills at the Neihu trash incinerator and assigned the Tri-service General Hospital to establish disaster scene emergency medical care exercises (including a temporary ambulance station, casualty care, radiation and medical facilities establishment, etc.); staff was stationed at the posts during the drill.

Chiu-yu Huang was sworn into the office of Director at the Shihlin District Health Service Center of Taipei City.

The 2010 Taipei International Flora Exposition came to a close; there were four nursing stations, one health care room and one Holiday Health Advisory Station set up in Yuanshan, Fine Arts, Xinsheng, and Dajia Parks from Taipei City's emergency care responsibility hospital for the emergencies and assisted ambulances. The Department of Health, Taipei City Government set up a website with a real-time reporting system to keep track of injury data, from November 6, 2010 for 171 days serving 12,376 person-times, a health care utilization rate of 1.3‰.

- Central authorities joined the Taipei City Government Drugs Hazard
 Control Center to serve; Tsong-ming Lin the deputy minister of Ministry of Education was the leader of the Central Authority.
- The Renai Branch of Taipei City Hospital held a celebratory activity for its 58th anniversary.

Sharfstein and Duke University Policy Director at the Center for Organizational Research Dr. Pickuei Tu with deputy director Dr. Cheryl Lin visited Department of Health, Taipei City Government; Commissioner of Department of Health Chi-hung Lin and Deputy Commissioner Kevin J. drill (Wanan No. 34) held at open space at Taipei Medical University in the Xinyi District and Xinyi Junior High School. It was mobilized by fire and emergency personnel from Taipei City Hospital (the Zhongxiao, Renai, Zhongxing, Heping Fuyou, and Yangming Branch), Taipei Medical University Hospital, Taipei Municipal Wanfang Hospital, Taiwan Adventist Hospital, Cathay General Hospital, and Tri-Sevice General Hospital, and the drill included a large number of injured patients. Xinyi District Health Service Center used emergency equipment and provided health services and cares to start the exercise.

All of the directly governing cities and counties had a fire emergency

- Held a community training course for smoking cessation stations; 114people attended. In 2011, 20 smoking cessation stations were added in pharmacies.
- The Yangming Branch of Taipei City Hospital held a celebratory activity for its 26th anniversary.
- Taipei City Government Nursing Association held a ceremony To celebrate the annual International Nurses Day.

Collaborated with Department of Economic Development Taipei City Government in conducting the 2011 2nd semi-annual joint inspection against the business premises of the 8 industries. 153 businesses were inspected; of them, 110 met the requirements, 15 failed, 20 closed down or not yet in operation, 8 not of the 8 industries under the governance of Taipei City operation hygiene self-management regulations. Ended on July 25.

Mongolian and Tibetan Affairs Commission summoned the 2011 1st Taiwan and Mongolia Medicine and Health Exchange Platform Meeting, chaired by the Director of Secretary Hui-ying Li. Kevin J. Chen, Deputy Commissioner of Department of Health, Taipei City Government attended the meeting. Two issues were discussed during the meeting: 1. Visitation by Inner Mongolia Department of Health and Reciprocal visit by Taiwanese group and free clinic in Inner Mogolia; 2. Visitation by Mongolia Ulanbaatar City Department of Health.

Taipei Medical University invited a 17 member medical professionaldelegation from mainland China to visit the Neihu Health Center in Taipei City.

Counseled the 4 supermarkets to start labeling calorie and other nutrition information on oden, hot dogs, buns and other cooked foods. In response to the coming of summer, in order to help consumers understand calorie content of refreshing drinks and ice products, counseled businesses to provide calorie labeling on fresh brewed coffee drinks, ice products, fresh coked meals, fresh baked bread, and other non-packaged food and beverages. At least 1,400 stores provided calorie labeling on non-packaged foods.

- Published 2010 Taipei City Health Statistics Annual Report to be distributed to relevant mechanisms and units to use. Also uploaded the information on to Department of Health, Taipei City Government website under "Health Statistics Information".
- 6 firms received training as part of the pilot for the maternity grant management system, including Taipei City Hospital, Dr. Hsu Obsgyn Clinic, Patty's clinic, the Cheng Hsin Hospital, and the Kang-Ning General Hospital.

Counseled the hand-blended drink industry on calorie information labeling of their products. There are currently about 150 companies in the industry that have started implementation of calorie labeling so that the public will have knowledge about the way in which retailers label calorie information and can reference it, allowing the consumer to drink according to her own taste and dieting and calorie needs.

In the Shilin Residence Hall, in accordance with the Tobacco Hazards Prevention Act enacted a full ban on smoking in certain places (on September 15 and 30 at the Flora Expo and in the Songshan Cultural & Creative Park; on October 1 at Lin An Tai Historcal House & Museum.

A new announcement was made to prevent the spread of the epidemic of enterovirus requiring Taipei City tutoring centers enrolling pre-school children to complete notifications of suspected cases of enterovirus disease within 48 hours. All those that fail to complete notifications accordingly will be penalized according to No. 37 of Communicable Disease Control Act. In addition, the regulations regarding enterovirus announced on June 15, 2010 by Department of Health, Taipei City Government was amended, changing "nursery" to "care institutions".

- Held an examination of the plans relating to Taipei City Hospital, all of its subordinate hospitals, and the 12 District Health Centers; ended on September 14.
- Launched the "Home Drug Safety Inspection Week' activities and organized an advocating garden party on July 30 for "Home Drug Safety Inspection and Take Back" for about 1,000 participants. The activities ended on July 30.

Conducted the "Taipei Shanghai City Forum and Municipal Visit" activity:

- Mayor Lung-bin Hau led the team to Shanghai City. During the event,
 Director of Department of Health, Taipei City Government Chi-hung Lin
 and Vice President of Taipei City Hospital Lin-chung Woung. Signed

On August 3, 11, 17, 18, and 19, held the 2011 regulations advocacy workshops for Chinese medicine traders and practitioners at the 5 divisions of the joint inspection team of Department of Health, Taipei City Government to improve awareness of Chinese medicine industry management and regulations of Chinese medicine traders and practitioners. Associate professor Hsien-chang Chang of Taipei Medical University Graduate Institute of Pharmacy was invited to give lectures on identifying Chinese medicines and safety of use and Committee on Chinese Medicine and Pharmacy technologist Yin-yin Lin to give lectures on different aspects of Chinese medicine pharmaceutical affairs. About 330 people attended the workshops.

Held the 2011 1st meeting of Gender Equality Ad Hoc Group. The Research and Planning Division, Department of Health, Taipei City Government gave reports on implementation plans of the Department of Health. Committee Chu-hui Chang was invited to give an overview presentation on gender mainstreaming at the meeting. The meeting decided on two items: 1. Enlist President Sun-yran Chang of Taipei City Hospital as a committee of the Gender Equality Ad Hoc Group of Department of Health; 2. Enlist 2 Department of Health gender matters contact persons.

Participants included Director of Department of Health, Taipei City Government Chi-hung Lin, actor Shun Zhao and his daughter, and CEO of John Tung Foundation Si-yuan Yao. About 50 people attended the press conference.

Director Chi-hung Lin represented the Department of Health, Taipei City Government in the event to shared and discuss Taipei City public health matters with international friends, public health officials, experts and key leaders in the U.S. and to enhance perspective and experience of international health exchanges. The event ended on September 2.

- Jingmei Hospital invited a 22-member delegation from the Anti-Tuberculosis Association, Shandong Province to visit the Department of Health, Taipei City Government to conduct exchanges on work of disease control in Taipei City.
- Taipei City Municipal Medical Institutions Medical Fund Supervision and Administration Commission set up a standing committee and summoned the 1st and 2nd standing committee meetings on September 16 and November 17, respectively.
- Taipei Economic and Trade Association invited a 14-member delegation from Xicheng District, Beijing to visit the Yangming Branch of Taipei City Hospital for exchanges on the branch's hospital management.
- Organized the 2011 Influenza Vaccination Contract Briefings. About 295
 Taipei City medical institutions conducted contract signings for all districts in Taipei City to successfully carry out 2011 influenza vaccination on October 1, 2011.
- Compiled and printed 2010 Taipei City Statistics on Life (Causes of Death)
 and distributed to relevant institutions and units for their use and uploaded
 the information onto the Department of Health, Taipei City Government
 website under "Life (Causes of Death) Statistical Information".

For 2011 routine site visits to densely populated institutions, cooperated with the division of elderly welfare, division of children and youth welfare, and division of physical and mental disabilities to inspect nursing homes, rehabilitation centers, and physical and mental disabilities, elderly care, youth welfare and orphanages and others institutions, a total of 21 institutions, for counseling on faults in infection control and requested the inspected institutions to make improvements. The project lasted till September 15.

Regarding stations that have not been measured in a long time or have abnormal measurements, the customer service center will contact personnel in charge of the telecare stations.

- Conducted the 2011 hospital earthquake disaster educational training and demonstration and drill for rescuing large number of the injured and ill with Taipei Municipal Wangfang Hospital for 200 participants.
 - Conducted the 2011 Achievement Publication for Activities and Care of the
 elderly with dementia at Nangand District Administration Center in Taipei
 City for 100 person times participants for activities.
 - An incident of Pertussis clusters happened in an elementary school in Nangang District, Taipei City. Up till October 10, a total of 6 cases of Pertussis were diagnosed. The incident was closed when no new cases were found during health monitoring continued through November 5.
 - Received a notification from hospital of a case of suspected Dengue fever that resided in Shilin District, Taipei City. On September 9, Centers for Disease Control, Department of Health, Executive Yuan confirmed as the first local Dengue fever case in Taipei City.
 - Held the 2011 committee for the consideration of the basis of charges of Department of Health, Taipei City Government affiliated medical institutions.
 - **9** Organized the "Colorful Mosaic" for the World Suicide Prevention Day.
 - **9** Heping Fuyou Branch, Taipei City Hospital organized a 43th anniversary celebration.

Organized the 2011 Taipei Gastric Cancer Screening Experts Forum. Professionals and scholars from different fields were invited to give their precious suggestions to be a reference for policy planning for promotion of gastric cancer screening practice in the future. The meeting concluded that an assessment for the feasibility for planning of subsidies for gastric cancer screening and Helicobacter pylori treatment for low-income households was needed.

Due to low temperature in the vaccine refrigerator, Department of Health, Taichung City Government suffered damage of 50,000 bottles of vaccine. To avoid such loss, Department of Health, Taipei City Government conducted renovation of the temperature monitoring system to increase detection points of the preservation of temperature monitoring system and strengthen low-temperature control function to ensure vaccine quality. Renovation concluded on September 23.

The appendix on the 8th point on "Points on accepting internship and training for Department of Health, Taipei City Government and its affiliated health centers" was amended in response to business needs.

Summoned jointly with Department of Social Affairs, Taipei City Government briefings of experimental design of Taipei City 2011 ICF new assessments for mental and physical disabilities and needs. Model of promotion of the Taipei City plans and modes of cooperation were described. All of the 23 hospitals involved in the plans sent delegates to attend the briefings.

Communicable Diseases Emergency Operations Center of Taipei City was established, initiating cross-departmental relevant disease control practices. By mobilizing daily personnel from health department, environmental protection department, district office, police and volunteers to conduct intensive breeding source removal work and completed the second household and environmental spraying on September 26. The epidemic slowly died out and the second level was lifted under the direction of the director at 5pm on September 27.

From September 8 there was one reported case of indigenous dengue fever; until November 19, after the monitoring period, there were a cumulative 23 confirmed cases of dengue fever in Taipei. There were 18 cases in the Shihlin District, 4 in the Zhongzheng District, and 1 in the Kaohsiung (living in the Zhongzheng District). The wave of indigenous fever infections occurred mainly in the Shihlin and Zhongzheng Districts. According to the monitoring results of the dengue epidemic, the last reported case of dengue was in the Lin Hing neighborhood of the Zhongzheng District in on October 1, and in the 31 days from that time there had been no reported cases; the epidemic ceased on November 1.

The McDonald's Foundation and the Women and Children's Branch of Taipei City Hospital held activities promoting influenza vaccinations and set up a clinic for free vaccination for pediatrics and family medicine.

Department of Health, Taipei City Government actively coordinated with Taipei City Hospitals to contract out publicly funded Tamiflu; the use of these antiviral agents at an as early stage as possible benefits high-risk groups and severely ill patients and decreases the emergence of sever symptoms and the death rate.
