Appendix: Chronicle of Major Events

2010 January

Major Events

- Activates the Taipei Schools and Organizations Reporting System for Communicable Diseases.
 - In collaboration with the Department of Economic Development, implemented joint inspection of business premises of the 8 major sectors that were registered. Between January 13 and March 2, 177 were inspected; of them, 120 passed, 35 were shut down, and 22 were fined for failing items.
 - 23 persons of different countries of the Medical Care Management
 Training of the Taiwan ICDF visited the Department of Health of the Taipei City Government.
 - Invited the Taipei Parks and Street Lights Office to assist in conducting the bidding of the building of 8 Smoking Cessation Counseling Areas (approved by the Mayor on December 31, 2009): Taipei City Hospital Zhongxing Branch (2 buildings), Renai, Heping, Yangming, Zhongxiao and Songde branches and the Taipei Main Station each with 1 building. The project was expected to be completed by December 13.
 - From January 25 to 29, the Laboratory provided free inspection services for mercury content in traditional Chinese medicine like Chinese medicine powder, tablets, pills, wine and other products.

<u>February</u>

Major Events

The Department of Health of the Taipei City Government expanded the 1-stop service for victims of sexual assaults, with a total of 7 service locations at Zhongxiao, Yangming, Women and Children, Zhongxing, Heping and Renai branches of the Taipei City Hospital and the Wanfang Hospital.

Conducted the "Women's cancer screening lottery" between February and June of 2010. All registered female with household registry of Taipei City could enter the monthly lottery when they accepted the Pap smear and mammogram for a total prize of NT\$500,000 (the Grand prize being NT\$100,000 cash award). About 80,000 person-times participated.

2010 February

Major Events

Lin Mei-zhu, Director of the Wenshan District Health Center of Taipei
City was transferred to become Secretary of the Department of Health
of Taipei City Government. Yan Yu-bin, the new director arrived and
took over the charge on the same day.

The Heping Branch of the Taipei City Hospital reported on a suspected case of typhoid in the Zhongzheng District of Taipei City. Test results confirmed positive on February 11. The case was employed at a restaurant (as a chef) in the Shilin District. Outbreak investigation found 27 employees had diarrhea. After inspection and counseling, the business was shut down for 2 days, on February 10 and 11. 69 Employees were selected for physical examinations. After testing, the norovirus outbreak was confirmed. The case was under health monitoring until February 28 and was closed due to no new cases.

March

Major Events

- The 2010 New Year Press Conference was held. 100 people attended, including media reporters, and staff members of the Department of Health and the affiliated Taipei City Hospital and District Health Centers.
 - Conducted the first work report for the Taipei City Government "Center of Dengue Prevention" and proposed to discuss the 2010 management plan of high-risk points of communicable diseases of the Taipei City Government; the event was based on the expanded execution mode of 2009.
 - 2010 First Review Conference of the executive auditing team of the joint fund of the Department.
 - Conducted a 32-hour training course on long-term care medication safety for pharmacists on March 7, 14, 21 and April 11, 2010. 236 pharmacists attended.
 - In collaboration with the Taipei Sports Office conducted the joint inspection of swimming pool safety management of Sports Centers. 10 Sports Centers were inspected between March 9 and 26 and all met the requirements.

2010 March

Major Events

- Summoned a conference on fighting against illegal advertising and strengthening inspection of banning strategies in collaboration with the Department of Information and Tourism of Taipei City Government.
- Conducted a public bidding of the reconstruction project of the sidewalk in front of the Wanfang Hospital and published the Government Procurement Gazette at the same time. On March 23, the Weisheng Construction Ltd won the bidding. The construction started on June 4 and finished on September 28. The work was inspected for acceptability on November 29 and re-inspected in early December.
- The 2010 first work conference (video conference) of Taipei City and County cooperated health and welfare group was held.

In response to Maokong Gondola resuming operations, a Maokong

- food health inspection and counseling team was set up to continue to counsel the 32 food and beverage industries in Maokong area on meeting the goal of good quality of self-management of sanitation, at the same time perform irregular mobility inspection to supervise the self-discipline of practitioners in the implementation of food health and safety.
- In line with the March 24 "World Tuberculosis Day", conducted the campus tuberculosis prevention comics contest to strengthen the knowledge and awareness of tuberculosis prevention of the children, parents and teachers in Taipei City; outstanding works were displayed in the Shen Pao-chen Hall of the Taipei City Hall.
- The Chinese Medical Report Semimonthly invited President Zhu Qingsheng of the Chinese Rural Health Association and others, a group of 7, to visit the Beitou District Health Center and the Yangming Branch of the Taipei City Hospital.
- The Health Care Car started running to encourage the citizens of Taipei City to actively participate in cancer screening and health promotion activities through the convenience of the Health Care Car service.

The Taipei Medical University invited the Department of Health of Shanghai City and Zhao Wuji, a medical care professional, and others totaling 27 people to come and visit the Department.

2010 April

Major Events

- Conducted the initiation press conference of the "Taipei City 4 2 Household Medical Waste Take-Back Station". The stations started operating at the same time.
 - Conducted the joint inspection of safety management of public and private swimming pools in collaboration with the Taipei Sports Office. They inspected 86 swimming pools between April 6 and May 13; 1 needed renovation while all the rest met the requirement.
 - By the joint effort with the John Tung Foundation and the Taipei City
 Hospital the free 4-week smoking cessation drugs service was put forth. The service ended October 31, serving 1,049 people.
 - Counseled the food and beverage industries of the Bamboo Lake to join the OK Accreditation System of the Certification for Selfmanagement of Sanitation activity and to simultaneously sign the 10 quality declarations. 32 businesses passed the certification.
 - The 2010 national municipalities, counties and cities disaster prevention and relief drill was held at Neihu Tzu Chi Garden District and Dahu Park. The Department mobilized 6 hospitals, including the Taipei City Hospital, to cooperate in executing disaster emergency medical drills.
 - Summoned the 2010 Forum of the Taipei City Network Platform Industry in strengthening the self-management in advertising, 40 network platform practitioners participated. Also invited the National Communications Commission, the Food and Drug Administration of the Department of Health of the Executive Yuan, and the Internet Advertising Media Association to attend as nonvoting delegates. 34 practitioners, or 66 people, participated.
 - Established the document quality counseling group. Led by Lin Jinfu, the Chief Secretary of the Department of Health of Taipei City Government, the group counseled the units with large text collection and documents of complicated nature between April 26 and 30 to improve the quality of document processing by colleagues.

The Department began the annual supervision a devaluation of primary medical care institutions and conducted 3,045 actual inspections (including 1,284 medical clinics, 1,241 dental clinics, 439 traditional Chinese medicine clinics and 81 other medical institutions).

The Department and the Taiwan Association of Asthma Education held a carnival "World Asthma Day ~~Be not afraid of allergic asthma, Take prevention and control early" at the Xiangdi Avenue Square of the Shin Kong Mitsukoshi Xinyi Palace of the Xinyi District for a total of 2,500 participants.

- The City Government document vetting team vet to promote the "2010 Taipei City Government Plan of Implementation of Effective Document Processing." The Department was rated 86.02 points and won the Grade A honor.
- Conducted the workshop on labeling and sanitation of commercially available packaged and loose food for a total of 134 participants.
- The Taipei City Government Suicide Prevention Center held an international seminar on suicide prevention under the global economic change for a total of 400 participants.

The Department conducted a workshop of the beginning course for medical personnel on organ solicitation at the Taipei Veterans General Hospital for a total of 250 participants.

A total of 67 tobacco control and inspection colleagues from the Health Promotion Division, the Joint Inspection Team and 12 District Health Centers participated.

Major Events

There occurred 4 cases of confirmed local measles cases in Taipei
City between June and July 1. The Centers for Disease Control of the
Department of Health of the Executive Yuan tested to be a Philippine
strain and it was listed as local cluster infection incidents.

2010 June

4

Major Events

Through the mechanism of the Exchange Platform of the Taipei-Mongolia Health and Medical Care Groups, the Department, in collaboration with the Mongolian and Tibetan Affairs Commission and the Taipei City Hospital, conducted an observation course in 2010 for 13 students. The opening ceremony was held on June 4. Among the visiting students 5 were assigned to the Women and Children Branch and 1 to the Zhongxiao Branch of the Taipei City Hospital for observation and study. A closing ceremony was held on August 23.

Director Bian Yundou of the Population and Family Planning Commission of Jinan City of mainland and others, a group of 12 VIPs, visited the Neihu District Health Center of Taipei City, and carried out a sharing and exchange of experiences in the area of diversification of the fertility policy.

Announced that when suspected enterovirus cases are found on campus, reporting to the system must be completed within 48 hours in order to prevent the spread of enterovirus outbreak. Those who do not complete reporting accordingly will be penalized according to the Article 37 of the Regulations on the Prevention of Communicable Diseases. In 2010 there were 2 cases of penalty due to delayed reporting.

Conducted the workshop on the vacuum-packed soy instant food manufacturing and retail industry hygiene for a total of 98 participants.

- 2010 the 2nd Joint Meeting of Cooperation and Promotion of Health and Social Welfare of Northern Taiwan Health Departments (video conference) was held.
- Began conducting the annual supervision and evaluation of hospitals and visits on medical care safety on 39 hospitals in Taipei City.

Invited the Law and Regulation Commission of Taipei City Government and the Department of Information and Tourism to summon the cross-bureau conference of coping strategies on illegal advertisings of drugs, cosmetics and foods.

The 2010 second work conference of Taipei City and County
Cooperated Health and Social Welfare Group (video conference) was held.

2010 June

Major Events

24 Student of the food safety workshop of the TaiwanICDF visited the Department and introduced the profile of the health and medical care of Taipei City and the food hygiene and safety management, inspection and operation.

In accordance with the 2010 Audit in Nosocomial Infection Control of the Centers for Disease Control of the Department of Health of the Executive Yuan, accompanied the committee of infection control experts to conduct the practical audit in infection control at hospitals above district level between June 24 to October 15 to improve the quality of infection control of hospitals of Taipei City.

On June 26 and 27, conducted educational training courses at community smoking cessation consultation stations for 153 participants; 34 new smoking cessation consultation pharmacists joined.

Conducted the seminar of the ethics of organ donation and no implementation of CPR at the Mackay Memorial Hospital for 226 participants.

Conducted the 2010 "advocacy trilogy workshop on youth tobacco control –tobacco trafficking" and "tobacco sales places – briefing of the evaluation of the effectiveness of the Tobacco Hazards Prevention Act" for a total of 740 tobacco retailers participated.

Held the Mid-year Press Conference and Networking Tea Reception (Health Quarterly, Taipei was the first) for 100 participants including media reporters, and staff members of the Department and its affiliated Taipei City Hospital and District Health Centers.

<u>July Major Events</u>

In collaboration with the Department of Economic Development, implemented the second half of 2010 joint inspection of business premises of the 8 major sectors. Between July 1 and July 30, 168 were inspected; of them, 135 met the requirements, 10 failed and 23 were shut down or not yet in operation.

2010 July

Major Events

Implemented a plan to provide patients in emergency beds by transferring patients in the 8 medical centers with mild and intermediate conditions to rooms at cooperating hospitals. The program served 35 patients.

In line with the pregnancy assistance program of the Taipei City Government, started a subsidizing plan for health examinations after marriage and before pregnancy and maternal serum screenings for Down's syndrome. All registered residents of the City that are married but without child or are expecting mothers of 11-20 weeks can receive free examination services at 25 contracted medical care institutions.

Revised the operating standards of the usage and management of the joint fund of the Department to be effective January 1, 2010.

Revised the important points on subsidizing of the Department of the incentive for difficult-to-recruit staff to be effective on July 2, 2010.

Conducted the seminar of medical personnel on organ and tissue solicitation (advanced clinical course) at NTUH for 215 participants.

- Conducted the "Home Drug Safety Inspection Week" advocacy garden party. About 3,000 person-times participated.
- Conducted the 2010 Cancer Prevention Carnival in the Shen Paochen Hall on the first floor of the Taipei City Government Municipal Building. Besides performances on the scene, the carnival provided a NT100,000 cash lottery with free cancer screening and women's cancer screening at the same time.
- A medical equipment delegation of 7 people of the Hubei Province of the mainland visited the Department and exchanged experiences regarding the profile of the health and medical care of Taipei City.
- Conducted the advocacy workshop on drug deals, pharmacies, pharmacist and regulations on controlled drugs to reinforce the awareness of relevant regulations on controlled drugs management of pharmacists; about 100 pharmacists attended the workshop.
- Jointly organized the 2010 workshop on regulations of contact lenses and regulations of consumer protection with the Taipei Optical Association, attended by about 80 people.

2010 July

Major Events

- Conducted the "Purification of advertisings the food industry workshop" for 110 participants from 98 businesses.
- In compliance with the Tobacco Hazards Prevention Act, announced the Jianguo business district (including the Flower Market, Jade Market, and Artist's Corner) to be a non-smoking area.

In order to train and develop seed instructors to advocate kidney disease prevention and drug safety, conducted the 8-hour beginner and advanced training courses. 195 pharmacists received training.

Received 1 notification of suspected imported paratyphoid fever

outbreak incident. After completion of the prevention measures, tracking, health management and specimen collection for re-examination, results were negative and thus the case was closed on August 30. The case started with people attending an Indian spiritual course between June 16 and July 8. Among group members from Taipei City, 16 displayed suspected symptoms and of them 4 were diagnosed positive for paratyphoid.

Between July 26 and July 30, the Laboratory conducted free acidity and total polar compounds testing for oil products to assist restaurant industry practitioners to implement frying oil self-management and set up the reference point for oil change.

Conducted the 2010 4-hour advanced training of community smoking cessation consultation stations for a total of 20 participants.

Conducted the review meeting of creative marketing proposal of the Department.

The Department won the fourth place in group A of "Taipei City Government each class 1 organization and district office in conducting the implementation plan of standard operating procedures award" and was publicly praised by the mayor during the 1587th City Council Meeting.

Participated in the 2010 first work contact conference of the influenza vaccination program of the Centers for Disease Control of the Department of Health of the Executive Yuan. The vaccination period of this year is between October 1 and November 30.

2010 July

Major Events

Summoned the first conference of the AIDS Prevention Promotion Commission. The conference resolved to strengthen advocacy on AIDS prevention by inviting the Department of Information and Tourism to cooperate with public and private owned radio stations to increase broadcasting of AIDS prevention advocacy during the public-interest hour of the Police Radio Station to increase awareness of AIDS prevention of the public.

Conducted the 2nd echelon of health self-management and baked food nutrition labeling and health workshops and simultaneously improved the capability of health self-management of the baking industry; a total of 109 businesses participated.

Invited the Law and Regulation Commission of Taipei City Government and the Department of Information and Tourism to summon the cross-departmental conference of major illegal advertisings of drugs, cosmetics and foods.

August

Major Events

- 8 5 Conducted inspection of densely populated institutions in Taipei City. 17 institutions were inspected between August 5 and October 14.
 - Produced calorie content posters for breakfast food to be posted extensively at 217 western-style breakfast restaurants near schools of all levels; at the same time counsel the breakfast restaurant owners on health self-management and to post declaration of quality to help consumers identify outstanding restaurants.
 - The Department conducted the "health promoting hospitals core workshop how to import and promote the HPH project" at Taiwan Adventist Hospital. A total of 55 people attended.
 - Physicians of Inner Mongolia of the mainland and others, a group of 7, visited the Department to understand the profile of health and medical care of Taipei City.
 - Announced the revision of the implementation measures of health 20 examinations and screenings of Taipei City citizens; a total of 10 articles were amended and 3 were added.

2010 August

20

Major Events

1 case of local dengue fever (virus strain was type 1 Thailand strain) occurred in the Beitou District. They concluded that it may be caused by a person with non-dominant infection traveled to Thailand and carried the virus back to his community as he returned and causing community infection from mosquito bite (with the disease strain) cases. The District response center was set up on August 25, with the Centers for Disease Control of the Department of Health, Beitou, Shilin, and Datong District Health Centers stationed at forward command posts; there are also members of the Department of Environmental Protection, District Office, and Beitou incinerator field.

Summoned the investment briefings of the operation transfer (OT) case of the Taipei City Sports Medicine Clinic chaired by Deputy Commissioner Lin Xiuliang; a total of 19 manufacturers attended.

Together with the Department of Social Welfare, the Police Department and the Sung Yang Social Welfare Foundation jointly conducted the "Dance to Stay Young and Vibrant" anti-drugs and protection of rights of children and youth advocacy activity at the Xiangdi Square and Xiangdi Avenue pedestrian zone of the Shin Kong Mitsukoshi Department Store of the Xinyi District. About 3,000 person-times attended.

- Conducted the 2010 Taipei Healthy City and Asian Male Health Symposium in collaboration with the Taiwan Urological Association and the Taipei City Hospital at the Taipei International Convention Center; invited experts scholars from 6-7 countries to speak and more than 200 people from 17 countries attended.
- Organized the briefings on the contract of cooperating hospitals in vaccination, influenza vaccination and pneumococcal vaccination.
- Completed the re-examination and counseling jobs of the on-scene public service evaluation conducted by the affiliated 12 District Health Centers and the Taipei City Hospital.

September

Major Events

Conducted irregular audit project on the documents of the Taipei City

Hospital of the Department and the 12 District Health Centers between September 6 and 14.

2010 September

Major Events

- Gonducted the "Purification of Advertisings Workshop on Drugs and Cosmetics Industry"; 104 people from 88 businesses attended.
- A mini-bus of the Southeast Bus Co. tipped over and fell down the valley while passing near the Bishan Temple of the Neihu District at 3:29 pm. The Taipei City Government launched the emergency medical care network to rescue at the scene and deployed the ambulance personnel of the Zhongxiao Branch of the Taipei City Hospital to standby at the scene. 12 injured were sent to hospital for medical care.

In collaboration with the Centers for Disease Control of the Department

of Health of the Executive Yuan, jointly conducted the 2010 active TB screening program for the economically disadvantaged group. The target was to provide TB screening for low-income residents aged 12 or above of Taipei City affordable housings: Ankang, Fumin, Yanji and Datong. They screened 273 people by October 31 and found 5 suspected TB cases; they simultaneously conducted reporting and management.

- The Department started conducting the operation of quality counseling visits of medical laboratory institutions.
- 2010 the third Work Conference of the Taipei City and County
 Cooperated Health and Social Welfare Group (video conference) was held.

Allen W. Chiu, Commissioner of the Department, acted as proxy of the Deputy Mayor of the Taipei City Government.

In collaboration with the Taiwan Alzheimer's Disease Association,

- Conducted the 2010 Taipei City Preschools Teachers' Seminar on Promotion of Vision and Oral Health at the Taipei Datong Sports Center for a total of 380 person-times over 2 echelons.
- organized the 2010 International Alzheimer's Disease Month advocacy activity at the Eastern Square of the National Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall. There they provided screenings for the "3 highs", points collection for the Wellness cards, and a question and answer activity related to Alzheimer's Disease with prizes. A total of 1,000 people attended the activity.

2010 September

Major Events

Conducted the activity of women's holiday group for health to exhort women to accept Pap smear, HPV specimen collection, mammography, fecal occult blood test and oral cavity examination. A total of 684 people attended.

The Asia Pacific Resort organized the Team Consensus Energy Camp of the Department and the Taipei City Hospital to rally team cohesion and improve inter-departmental communication and cooperation for a total of 29 participants.

- Conducted the 2010 3rd Joint Meeting of Cooperation and Promotion of Health and Social Welfare of Northern Taiwan Health Departments (video conference)
- Announced revision on the operation procedure of subsidies on joint fund of the Department of Health to be effective on September 23, 2010.
- The Taipei Healthy City won the "Innovation Achievement Award of the 2010 Taiwan Healthy City Awards Selection" for its friendly space, urban security, information technology, community involvement, creative industries, environmental improvement and arts and leisure.
- Organized the health education garden party of the World Heart Day in collaboration with the DOH Bureau of Health Promotion and the Taiwan Society of Cardiology and Taiwan Heart Foundation, at the Eastern Square of the National Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall, for a total of 1,000 participants.
- Conducted the 2010 briefings of health self-management and health workshop of the restaurant and food vending industries for 172 people; counseled businesses to participate in the certification of health self-management.

<u>October</u>

Major Events

The second meeting of the deputy heads of the Northern Taiwan Regional Development Promotion Committee was held.

Cooperated with the Centers for Disease Control of the Department of Health of the Executive Yuan in conducting the 2010 Influenza Vaccination Program.

2010 October

Major Events

- Jointly conducted the 2010 Academic Thematic Forum of Hot Spring

 Health Care Tourism with the Taipei Hot Springs Association and the National Taipei College of Nursing.
- Conducted the "World Arthritis Day Health, of Joints, Key to Health"

 Garden Party in collaboration with the Arthritis Foundation at the National Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall for a total of 500 people.
- Conducted the "Purification of advertisings Workshop for the media industry" for 107 participants from 105 businesses.
- In cooperation with the Central Authorities, conducted the visitations to Taiwan of the experts from Haiti of communicable disease prevention, to understand AIDS risk-reduction implementation strategies, effectiveness and experiences in implementing AIDS prevention; visited the Methadone Alternative Therapy executive body and clean syringe exchange at community pharmacies.
- Carried out a trial operation of the 2010 Taipei International Flora Exposition with the Taipei City Hospital, Mackay Memorial Hospital, Cheng Hsin General Hospital, and Taipei Chang Gung Memorial Hospital implementing support and ambulance related operations at the medical care stations in the 4 park areas. The trial operation served 302 person-times.

The Department combined effort with the Department of Health of Taipei County Government and private social welfare organizations and conducted a large scale propaganda activity for the tenth anniversary of the Depression Screening Day, at the Xiangdi Square of the Shin Kong Mitsukoshi Department Store of the Xinyi District, for over 2,000 person-times participation.

- Conducted the first echelon of health workshops for practitioners of the body (eyebrow) tattooing and ear piercing industry; a total of 47 people attended and were given certificate of attendance.
 - On October 11 and 15 each had 1 case of cholera confirmed (O1-Ogawa and O139 serotypes respectively). Specimen collection from contacts and environmental and food sample testing all gave negative results. Re-collection of 3 sets of stool samples of contacts after completion of treatment also gave negative results. Both contacts had no symptoms, thus the cases were closed on October 25 and November 3 respectively.

2010 October

- Conducted the Youth Health Promotion Seed Teachers Workshop at the Taipei Long Men Junior High School on October 13 and 14; the 2 echelons were attended by a total of 334 person-times.

In line with the World AIDS Day 2010, this year jointly conducted the "SHOW-Love Film Festival Train Tour" activity with the Department of Health of Taipei County Government and the Nurses AIDS Prevention Foundation; Miss Huang Yunling, a well-known musician, was invited to speak for the activity and respond to the national HIV screening. A press conference was held on October 15. In total, 96 sessions had been held by December 3.

On September 19, he was shot with a gun while doing an interview in India and sent to a local hospital for medical care. On September 27, he rode an SOS plane to return to Taiwan for isolation care. On October 1, specimen collection result showed he was an asymptomatic carrier NDM-1 intestinal infection; it was not a notifiable disease.

In collaboration with the Department of Civil Affairs of Taipei City

Government and the Taiwanese Injury Prevention and Safety Promotion Association, the 2010 Taipei International Symposium on Community Safety and Health in conjunction with ANMC21 Conference on Combating Infectious Diseases was held. The convention was divided into 3 main themes: the 2010 Conference of Strategies of Prevention Diseases of Asian Network of Major Cities was held on November 9 ~11 to discuss the novel influenza, dengue fever, tuberculosis, AIDS and other issues and to give keynote addresses and sharing of experiences on disease prevention by each city member; The ANMC21 Conference had a total of 105 participants. The 2010 Taipei International Symposium on Community Safety and Health was held on November 9 with expert scholars from 8 countries and a total of 362 participants.
