Taipei Pass Terms and Conditions

How to Use it:

The Taipei Pass allows for unlimited rides on the Taipei Metro system and associated bus services in Taipei City and New Taipei City during the period of its validity. Users are required to tap the card over the EasyCard sensor area on fare gates in Taipei MRT stations and on buses (buses that accept the card will display a Taipei Pass identification sticker). The Maokong Gondola 1-Day Pass is valid for unlimited trips on the Maokong Gondola.

EasyCard Customer Service Center at Taipei Main Station; information counters at all Taipei MRT stations.

* Please be noted that the Pass cannot be used for buses with 4-digit route numbers.

Evenings in Taipei are relaxing and the city features a colorful, bustling night life. Spread throughout the city, the night markets are the best attractions for visitors and diners.

Night markets in Taipei city feature a variety of merchandise including clothing, jewelry and accessories. Also they are the best places for looking for traditional souvenirs. The most unforgettable characteristic of these markets, however, is their snacks. A variety of types and flavors of these traditional foods give visitors a delicious and unforgettable experience.

Night markets in Taipei show the diverse culture and food habits of Taiwan and have been one of the tourist attractions for foreign visitors. Recently, Taipei city government has made efforts to plan and support the night markets, transforming into a renewed image and with unique characteristics and combining with the recreation in the neighborhood. In addition, tourists not only have the opportunity to enjoy traditional culture, but also gain an excellent experience at night markets.

This book helps visitors make good use of the Taipei MRT network to arrive at the various night markets, and provides information about the unique snacks and popular items.

Huaxi Street Tourist Night Market

Huaxi Street Night Market has a 50-year history. With its canopy, palace-style archway and lanterns, Huaxi Street was recognized in 2010's as the best night market for shopping. Huaxi Street was famous for medicinal foods made with snakes and soft-shelled turtles in the early days. However, in recent years many unique businesses, such as foot massage parlors and name painting stalls, have also set up shop here. There are many delicacies here that should not be missed, such as Mochi, Dan Zai noodles, and pork-meat soup.

Asia Soft-Shelled Turtle

The nearly 40 year's old shop, Asia Soft-Shelled Turtle, is one of the elders in Huaxi Street, and the turtle cuisine has been the local specialty. Soft-shelled turtles are nutritious and suit to be fried, boiled, stewed, braised and so on. The shop is senior of cooking soft-shelled turtle and other delicacies like fried crocodile and soft-shelled turtle herbal soup. You don't see these kinds of food in other places. If you dare, you can try the tonic drink "Yellow, Green, Red", the turtle's egg, bile, and blood mixed with rice wine.

Eating and Praying at the Longshan Temple

ongshan Temple at Monga, built during the days period of Qianlong Emperor of the Chinese Qing Dynasty, has been an exquisite architecture of high artistic merit and one of the most popular tour destinations in Taipei. The main deity worshipped in the temple is Guanyin (Avalokitesvara), and the temple is built as a traditional three layer Chinese quadrangle. The temple features many famous artworks by renowned calligraphers and sculptors, and is the site of the only cast copper dragon pillar in Taiwan. After visiting Longshan Temple, the 4 night markets in Xichang Street, Wuzhou Street, Guangzhou Street and Huaxi Street are great places to hang out and taste local delicacies.

Xichang Street Tourist Night Market

any scenes of the 2010 hit film Monga was Mshot at the nearby Longshan Temple, Herb Lane, and Bopiliao, and the area became one of the most popular tourism destinations as a result. Xichang Street Tourist Night Market is located right next to Longshan Temple, and the area has long been a commercial hub. Recently Taipei City Government has re-organized the layout of the night market so that the stalls are now located in the middle of the street. The stalls near Guangzhou Street usually sell clothes and household items while the food is found on Xichang Street near Guilin Road. Famous foods that can be found here include pot sticker, oily glutinous rice, four-herbal soup, and herbal tea. If you find yourself visiting Longshan Temple to pray for luck, why not take a stroll down Xichang Street?





Kangding Road and Guangzhou Street. The block reserves the building in early 20th century. The Barogue-like and Gothic-like buildings with red bricks make a century long contrast to the modern building across the street. The nostalgia scene is fascinating.

Nanjichang Night Market

Nalley between lane 307 and 315, Sec. 2, Zhonghua Road. The night market received its namesake because there was an airport, or "jichang", nearby during the days of Japanese occupation. The public housing built later made this location a hub of activities and a place famous for cheap snack food. Different items are on sale during the day and at night. Many dumpling restaurants have opened in lane 309 in recent years, and as a result the lane is now known as the Dumpling Lane. In 2012, Nanjichang Night Market became internationally renowned for its delicious Taiwanese meatballs.

The Artist's Corner

Janguo Artist's Corner is a special zone for selling art Jarticles and holding activities. The lines of booth are selling various creations like leather goods, handicrafts, crystal glass, painting, pottery, and carved stones. Many of them are created by physically challenged people at their homes, and the paintings in the gallery are created by people with audio difficulties. Street performers sometimes show up here as well. So, why not come here to experience the multiple arts in holidays.





Knowledge of Jade

Jianguo Holiday Jade Market consists of thousands venders and could be the biggest Jade bazaar in Asia. There are diverse Jade products and antiques shown here. Some of them show delicate craft or creative ideas. You can try touching jade and feeling the texture of it just like in an open jewel museum.

If you want to purchase jade, you can evaluate it by the color, clearness, and the distribution of color. Besides, the craft level also affects the price. After the purchase, maintenance would be important. The jade should not be clean with high temperature, acid, regular cleaner, or ultrasonic cleaning. It is supposed to be mopped with warm water and let it air-try under room temperature.



Dalong Street Night Market

Onfucius and Baoan Temple, features different foods during the day and at night. In the morning, there are many stalls and restaurants that provide Taiwanese-style breakfast like fried egg pancake, rice, noodles and congee. At night, the traditional restaurants open to feed Dongshan duck head, Dan Zai noodles, Taiwanese meatballs, pepper popcorn chicken to the throng of fans. Come for the history, and stay for the night market food!

It is believed that no one should show off his literateart in front of Confucius, so the pillars, girders, doors and windows do

not have words or couplets carved on them. That makes the building simple but sacred. There are many ancient type ceremonial and music instruments exhibited in the temple. Every September 28th, the temple holds the Confucius Ceremony to worship Confucius with ancient music, Bayi dance and sacrifices by Confusion tradition.



Dishes Inspired by Confucius

The Feast of Confucius, consisted of dishes inspired by the stories of Confucius and designed by renowned food designers, can be found in restaurants in Dalong Night Market. You can find the "Qi Jun Zi Yu" (the fish that lied to a gentleman) and the "Cang Zhen Do Fu" (precious treasure tofu) at Little Li's Seafood Restaurant (advanced order required), the "Gu Shuo Xi Yang" (Lamb of Worship) in Tsai's Shacha Sauce Lamb Restaurant. Other dishes include the Guan Shi Zhi Ji (stolen chicken), Yang Huo Kui Tun (a gift of pork), Xin Zhong Da Niu (the cow that is spared), and Jun Chen Zuo Zhou (congee for the emperor and his subjects). The wide variety of dishes will give you a taste of Confucianism you will never forget.

Xingtian Temple & Fortune-telling Street

Thousands of believers come to Xingtian temple, also called Enzhugong temple, every day. It could be the temple with the most worshipers in northern Taiwan. The temple always does the famous chanting and praying ceremony, exorcism rituals and divination. Moreover, the temple does not have donation box or raise offering, and they forbid offering animal sacrifices as well as burning paper or insane as offering, either. Their policy has been advocated by many worshipers.

The so-called fortune-telling street has been in Songjiang road for over 30 years. Because the place is near Xingtian temple, many believers would draw divining lots and go to this underground road to consult the fortune tellers. The unique culture also makes some foreign guests coming to try.
