Food Waste That Can be Turned into Compost

Classification Guideline: Inedible Organic Substances
 Ex.: Peels, Shells, Bones, Cores, Flowers, Leaves, Tea Residue, Coffee Grounds and any Food Waste containing rotten foods makes it inedible for pigs.
 *Coconut shells and durian peels have to be collected separately and sent for recycling.



Food Waste That Can be Turned into Pig Feed

Classification Guideline: Leftovers or foods that are no longer needed at home, whether raw or cooked, as long as they are edible for pigs after being heated.
 Ex.: Meat, Inner Organs, Vegetables, Fruits, Frozen Foods, and food or ingredients that are expired but not yet rotten.

Large Furniture, Home Appliances & Four Major Electric Appliances (TV sets, Refrigerators, Washing machines, Air conditioners and Heaters)

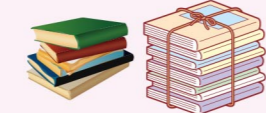
Flat Waste

All used clothes that are cleaned before recycling (including female underwear with a clean elastic integrity).

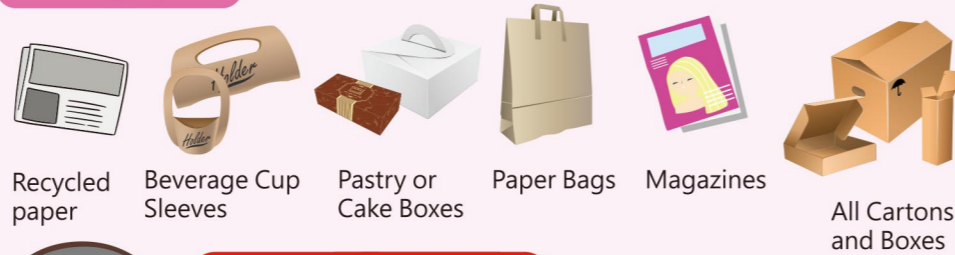


Plastic Bags

All plastic bags that are cleaned before recycling; (clean up all the grease stains, food residue, and blood, etc.)
