January 1

Structure construction for Station Y6 of the Circular line Contract CF641 was completed.



February 12

In collaboration with the Taichung City Government, a series of activities and a parade were held to greet the first train of Taichung MRT.



February 23

February 23

July 15 2017 William Jones Cup International Basketball Tournament was held at the basketball gymnasium of Heping Elementary School - Contract IZVX33.




August 9

The contractor commenced construction of the project to redevelop the external wall at Taipei Arts Center as the first tender of the commissioned work.




August 11

The first train of the Circular line was tested on the test track.




September 16

The beam ceremony of Contract CZ210 for Taan Elders Service and Day Care Center project was held.




October 12

15

Completing the establishment of computer 3D data of the Taipei MRT underground structure, including 75 MRT underground stations, 105 passages and 225-km underground tunnels. The 3D data will also be submitted to Public Works Department, Taipei City Government.
