In order to consolidate and improve the efficiency of its districts, Taipei City Government reduced the number of the city's districts from 16 to 12 on March 12, 1990. The area from the south side of the Songshan Dist. Railway Station and the area from the north side of section 3, Heping E. Rd. of Daan Dist. were combined and given the name "Xinyi District".

With the greatest number of landmark buildings, Xinyi Dist. is considered the political, economic, and cultural center of Taipei City.

# Taipei 101

# Songshan Cultural and Creative Park

Established as a tobacco-factory complex in 1937, this was Taiwan's first modern tobacco plant. Production was ceased in 1998. After transformation into a cultural-creative park in 2011, the former plant and warehouses are now used as cultural-creative platforms and exhibition spaces.

# **Xiangshan Park**

This park, located at the foot of Xiangshan, is home to the Taipei Green Treefrog, a protected species.. This is a place where recreation and ecoenvironment is combined.
