Taking Ketamine will cause harm to the Urinary System

- Taking Ketamine will lead to chronic interstitial cystitis.
- Taking Ketamine will cause severe, frequent urination, urgent, painful urination, hematuria, lower abdominal pain, and even renal insufficiency such as decreased urine output and edema.
- More severe conditions may include bladder wall fibrosis and thickening. In these cases, the original bladder has to be replaced with an artificial bladder through bladder reconstruction surgery.
- Long-term abuse will lead to tolerance and psychological dependence and cause compulsive use, which is hard to abstain from.



Your curiosity will lead to trouble; you will end up wearing diapers for the rest of your life.



Related Penalties for Ketamine

According to regulations of the "Narcotics Hazard Prevention Act" and "Unified Standards of Penalty and Workshop for Narcotics Hazardous Events", Ketamine is listed and controlled as a category three narcotic. Possession, consumption and inviting others to take Ketamine will be penalized.



Possession or consumption



NT\$20,000~NT\$50,000 fine
Narcotics hazard workshop for 6~8 hours



Possession of 20g Ketamine

NT\$300,000 fine
Imprisonment for three years

Inviting others to consume



NT\$700,000 fine
Imprisonment for 6 months~5 years
