Financial Assistances



Social Assistance Scheme for Foreign Spouses Prior to Household Registration

Targets

A person from a listed low-income or mid/low-income family in the city whose spouse is a foreigner without household registration and income is below the minimum living standard. Subsidies provided include livelihood assistance, medical subsidy, and emergency assistance. A foreign spouse without household registration refers to one of the following: (1) a foreign spouse in an existing marriage who has yet to obtain household registration, (2) a widowed foreign spouse who has yet to obtain household registration or (3) a divorced foreign spouse with sole custody of the child(ren) who has yet to obtain household registration.

Must have lived in Taiwan for more than 183 days in the past year.

Assistance for Families in Special Circumstances

Targets

A new immigrant who is married to a citizen of Taipei City and is in hardship (e.g., husband missing/serving prison terms/dead; divorced due to deliberate abandonment or abuse by the husband; victims of domestic violence; unmarried pregnancy; unemployed and raising children alone under the age of 18; struck by a major incident within the past 3 months), thus requiring short-term financial assistance.

Assistances include: emergency assistance for livelihood, child daycare allowance, granting their children the priority of being accepted into public day-care facilities, child education subsidy, medical subsidy, injury-examination subsidy, subsidy for psychological treatment, subsidy for litigation, loans for starting a new business, discount on women's curricular programs, and child living allowance.

Has married to a citizen of Taipei City and is actually living in the city. No limitations in terms of the location of the registered household.

Subsidies for Victims of Sexual Assault

Targets

1.Targets of subsidies are sexual assault victims.

2.Subsidies include:

- Emergency Livelihood Assistance: For victims of sexual assault (i.e. the applicants)
- Litigation Subsidy: For victims of sexual assault (i.e. the applicants)
- Injury Examination Subsidy: For victims of sexual assault (i.e. the applicants)
- Psychological Rehabilitation Subsidy: For victims of sexual assault or their family members (important others)

Must have the household registered in Taipei City, but one who lives in the city and is assessed by the competent authority to be in need of assistance is exempt from the household registration restriction.

Subsidies for Victims of Domestic Violence

Targets

1. Targets of subsidies are domestic violence victims.
2. Subsidies include:
 - Injury Examination Subsidy: For victims of domestic violence (i.e. the applicants)
 - Psychological Rehabilitation Subsidy: For victims of domestic violence (i.e. the applicants)
 - Housing and Accommodation Subsidy: For victims of domestic violence (i.e. the applicants)
 - Subsidy for Rental and Other Necessary Living Expenses: For victims of domestic violence (i.e. the applicants)

Must have the household registered in Taipei City, but any national without household registration, foreigner or resident of China, Hong Kong or Macao who is married to or is in a common law relationship with a citizen of Taipei City is exempt from the household registration restriction.

Emergency Assistance

Targets

1. Any citizen from a household not listed as low-income family in the city who can't afford the cost of a funeral for a family member that has passed away.
2. Any Taipei City citizen who is facing hardship in life as a result of an accident or a serious illness occurring to a household member.
3. Any Taipei City citizen who is facing hardship in life because the primary earner in the family is currently unemployed, missing, serving in the military or doing substitute military service, jailed, being taken into custody, detained or unable to work for other reasons.
4. Any Taipei City citizen who is facing hardship in life as a result of being unable to utilize his/her assets or deposits promptly due to the compulsory execution or freezing of his/her assets and bank accounts or other reasons.
5. Any Taipei City citizen who is facing hardship in life as a result of a major misfortune and has been visited and evaluated by the DOSW or the district office to be in need of assistance.
6. Any person not domiciled in Taipei City who doesn't have the fare money to return home or has suffered an injury or died in the city as a result of a natural disaster or a major accident is eligible to apply and shall be granted assistance by the DOSW or the district office accordingly.

Emergency Livelihood Assistance for Children/Youth of Disadvantaged Families

Targets

1. Children or youth under the age of 18
2. Children or youth who have not been located under government assistance
3. Children or youth who are teenage mothers, victims of domestic violence or who are in hardship because their parents are divorced, dead, missing, unemployed, ill, in prison, drug abusers or alcoholics, or because of a major incident.
4. By calculating the total family income divided by the number of persons in the family, the monthly income per capita is under our nation's median disposable income for the past year, the average value of movable properties per person (including stocks, investments, and savings) is NT\$150,000 or less, the total value of immovables owned by the family (including lands and houses) is lower than NT\$6.5 million, or there is a proof of living in hardship for the past year. Short-term livelihood assistance is to be provided for up to 6 months.

NHI Premium Payment Subsidy for Children and Youth of Mid-low Income Families

Targets

Children and youth of mid-low income families in Taipei City under the age of 18

Must be domiciled in Taipei City.

Low-income Household Assistance

Targets

- 1.The average family income per capita per month is below the minimum living standard.
- 2.The average savings per capita (including stocks, investments, and deposits) does not exceed NT\$150,000.
- 3.The total value of lands and houses owned by the family does not exceed NT\$6.55 million

Assistances include the following: family living assistance, NHI and partial payment subsidy, medical subsidy, money for nutritional products, childbirth subsidy, child daycare subsidy, education subsidy, school transit subsidy, and tuition reduction/exemption.

Must have the household registered in Taipei City, must actually reside in the city and must have lived in the country for more than 183 days in the past year.

Care Now Emergency Relief

Targets

Persons who have fallen into hardship as result of illness or injury, unemployment, death or disappearance of a family member, or other incidents and who are unable to obtain any relief or insurance payout can apply for emergency relief for incidents occurred in the past 3 months. For any particular incident, a single application is allowed. However, if a person's life remains in hardship after receiving the emergency relief, he/she can be granted the assistance for the second time once being verified to be in need following a visit and evaluation.

Daycare Services

Child Care Subsidy for Children in Disadvantaged Families

Targets

- Children who are 12 years old or younger and whose households are registered in Taipei City and meet one of the following conditions:
- 1. Living in a low-income household acknowledged by the city government.
- 2. Preschoolers put in foster families by the department.
- 3. Being put in the orphanage by the department.
- 4. Children of families in crisis.
- 5. Children under the age of 6 coming from families in special circumstances.
- 6. Children assessed by the department to be in need of emergency resettlement (i.e. children under improper care who are assessed to require immediate resettlement by the department.)

Tuition Subsidy for Children of Age 5

Targets

- 1. Children age 5 attending kindergartens (the period between September 2 of current year and September 1 of next year)
- 2. Being a R.O.C. national
- 3. Attending a public or private kindergarten that meets the provisions of the Regulations Governing Subsidies for Children Attending Kindergartens

Temporary Child Care Assistance

(including institutes, babysitters, and temporary at-home care providers)

Targets

- 1. Low-income household.
- 2. One of the parents is an aboriginal.
- 3. Either the father or the mother has moderate (or worse) physical or mental disabilities.
- 4. A sibling of the child who lives in the same household is a holder of the Physical and Mental Disability ID or a proof of being developmentally delayed.
- 5. Single-parent family.
- 6. Multiple births.
- 7. Either one of the parents has become unemployed involuntarily and needs to look for a new job.
- 8. Anyone who does not meet the above criteria but is assessed to be in need of temporary child care by the department's welfare service centers, women service centers, single-parent service centers and so on and has the approval of the department.

Partial Child Care Subsidy for Employed Parents

Targets

Both parents (guardians) are or the single parent is employed, or one of the parents is employed and the other one is moderately/severely handicapped, currently performing the mandatory military service or currently serving a prison term or under a rehabilitative measure that is longer than 1 year, and as a result, are unable to take care of the less-than-2-year-old child at home on their own, needing to make use of the Community Babysitter Support and Supervision Network or a babysitter from a child care center. Must also meet the following conditions:

1. Ordinary family: A monthly subsidy of NT\$2,000-3,000 per child is granted to a family that the sum of all income by both parents/guardians (or the single parent) for the past year, as approved by the taxation authority, is under the threshold for tax declaration or is taxable at an income tax rate under 20%.
2. Disadvantaged family: A monthly subsidy of NT\$3,000-5,000 per child is granted to mid-low income families, low-income families, families with a developmentally-delayed or handicapped child under the age of 2, families in special circumstances, and high risk families.

Partial Child Care Subsidy for Families with More than 3 Children

Targets

A child under the age of 2 with two or more siblings registered to the same mother or father who is in need of care by a nanny associated with the Community Babysitter Support and Supervision Network or a legally-registered day care center and who must also meet the following conditions:

1. Ordinary family: A monthly subsidy of NT\$2,000-3,000 per child is granted.
2. Disadvantaged family: A monthly subsidy of NT\$3,000-5,000 per child is granted to mid-low income families, low-income families, families with a developmentally-delayed or handicapped child under the age of 2, families in special circumstances, and high risk families.

Childcare Allowance

Targets

An applicant (the parent, guardian or actual care provider of a child) who meets the following provisions may apply at the Social Affairs Section of the district office where the child's household is registered, and a monthly allowance of NT\$2,500 per child is granted if approved:

1. Caring for a child under the age of 5
2. The child and the applicant must be domiciled in Taipei City and must have actually lived in the city for over a year.
3. The total income of the applicant for the past year is found to have not reached the filing threshold by the taxation authority or whose income tax is calculated using a rate lower than 20%. The same applies when the applicant is declared as the dependent of a taxpayer who meets the above scenarios.
4. The child has not been placed and settled on governmental fund.
5. The child has not been a recipient of the livelihood subsidy for low-income households, the livelihood subsidy for children/youth of families in crisis, or any other livelihood subsidies and allowances.

Being domiciled in Taipei City for over a year, as prescribed by Item 2 of the above paragraph, refers to an uninterrupted period longer than a year going back from the date of application.

A child who meets one of the following conditions shall be exempt from the household registration and residence restriction prescribed in Item 2 of the 1st paragraph:

1. The child is under the age of 1, has his/her birth and initial household registered in Taipei City and has no record of emigration with his/her household registration.
2. The adoption of the child was registered less than a year ago, and there is no record of emigration following his/her household registration in Taipei City.

A child shall be exempt from the household registration and residence restriction prescribed in Item 2 of the 1st paragraph if one of the child's parents is a national without household registration, a Mainland Chinese resident or a foreigner.

Childcare Allowance for Unemployed Parents

Targets

- A. There is no household registration restriction for this particular allowance; however, the following conditions must be met.
 1. Caring for a child under the age of 2
 2. At least one of the child's parents (guardians) is unable to work because of the need to take care of the child.
 3. The family has been acknowledged as a low-income or mid-low income household by the special municipal government or the county/city government in accordance with the Social Assistance Act or the total income of the parents (guardians) is below the tax filing threshold approved by the taxation authority or whose income tax is calculated using a rate lower than 20% for the year designated by the central competent authority.
 4. The child has not been placed and settled on governmental fund.
 5. The family is not currently receiving the unpaid parental leave allowance or the baby-sitting subsidy in taking care of the child.
 - B. An unemployed applicant, as prescribed by Item 2 of the previous paragraph, shall meet the following provisions, but the application by an unemployed applicant, under special circumstances, shall be examined by the special municipal or county/city government with supporting documents presented by the applicant:
 1. Not participating in the labor insurance
 2. The sum of all salaries and wages and income from professional practices (except for author's remunerations) for the year designated by the central competent authority, as approved by the taxation agency, is less than the amount equal to 12 times the year's minimum monthly wage.
- Note: "Childcare Allowance for Unemployed Parents" and "Taipei City Childcare Allowance" belong to the same category of subsidies. An applicant who meets the criteria for both allowances may only apply for the more favorable one of the two.

Have a Care-free Pregnancy Program - Tuition Subsidy for 5-Year-Old Children (Preschool Education Division, Department of Education)

Targets

- From Sept. 2 of the respective year to Sept. 1 of the following year, children over the age of 5 but under the age of 6 who meet one of the following conditions:
 1. The child has his/her household registered in Taipei City and attends one of the city's registered child care institute as an enrollee within the ratified quota.
 2. The child attends a registered child care institute outside of the city as an enrollee within the ratified quota who has been domiciled in the city, along with his/her parent(s) or guardian, under the same household for more than 6 months prior to Aug. 1 for the first semester and Feb. 1 for the second semester and continues so until the end of the semester.

Priority Kindergarten Admission for Children of New Immigrants (Preschool Education Division, Department of Education)

Targets

A child over the age of 5 whose father or mother was originally a foreign citizen

Education Subsidy for Parents of Physically/Mentally Disabled Children (Special Education Division, Department of Education)

Targets

Must concurrently meet the following conditions:

- 1.The child must be over age 2 but under age 6.
- 2.The child must be domiciled in Taipei City under the same household as one of his/her parents or his/her legal guardian and must have lived in the city for over a year (as noted on the Household Registration Certificate).
- 3.The child is a holder of the Physical and Mental Disability ID, the Catastrophic Illness Certificate issued by the Bureau of National Health Insurance or the certificate of diagnosis or assessment report by one of Taipei City's early intervention medical institutes that shows the child has been evaluated as "developmentally delayed".
- 4.The child must be verified as a special education student by the Committee Responsible for Identification and Placement of Gifted and Learning Disabled Students and has studied in a registered private kindergarten for over a semester. An education subsidy of NT\$5,000 per semester is granted.

Pre-Admission Identification and Placement of Pre-School Gifted and Learning Disabled Children (Special Education Division, Department of Education)

Targets

Must concurrently meet the following conditions:

- 1.The child must be over age 2 but under age 6.
- 2.The child must actually live and be domiciled in Taipei City or must be a foreign national/ overseas Chinese residing in the city (passport and Alien Resident Certificate need to be shown).
- 3.The child is a holder of the Physical and Mental Disability ID, the Catastrophic Illness Certificate issued by the Bureau of National Health Insurance or the certificate of diagnosis or assessment report by one of Taipei City's early intervention medical institutes that shows the child has been evaluated as "developmentally delayed".
- 4.A child who has been verified as a special education student by the Committee Responsible for Identification and Placement of Gifted and Learning Disabled Students can have priority admission into the city's public kindergarten to get special education services.

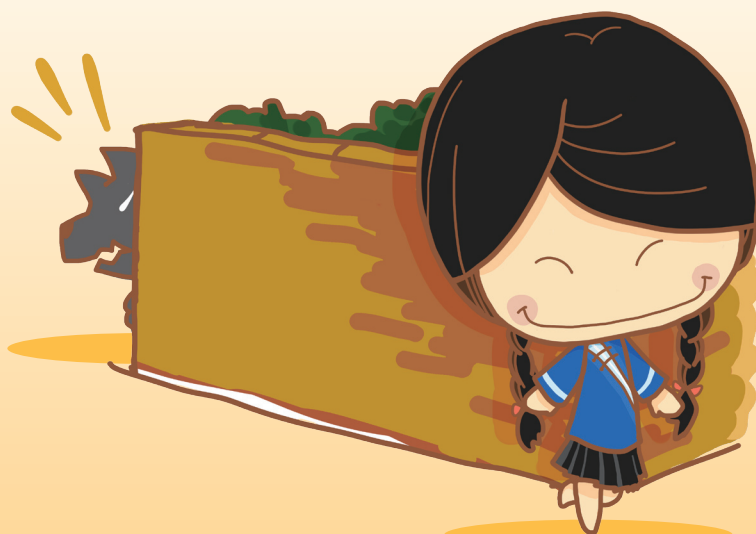
